

“Corvettes at CORSA” is moving to a virtual car show this year.

With so many car shows being cancelled or postponed this year, this is your chance to participate in a show, have some fun, and do some good all at the same time.

Corvettes at CORSA has been held every year for the last 17 years in order to raise money for OhioGuidestone. OhioGuidestone is an Ohio charity that began in 1864 as an orphanage in Berea, Ohio. Today they offer foster care and family services in many locations around the state. They rely on donations to operate so Corvette Cleveland and Corsa Performance decided to move our cancelled traditional car show to an online car show for 2020. This will allow us and the entire corvette community to provide support during these difficult times. The show will run from July 22 to August 12, 2020.

As in the past, we will be presenting our unique “exhaust tip” trophies, made from actual stainless steel Corsa exhaust tips, to the top 3 places in each generation Corvette. The best of each generation will be selected by one of our celebrity judges. Second and third places will be selected by a panel of judges. There will be a special OhioGuidestone Choice Award (Gold Exhaust Tip) for a total of 25 trophies. This will be your chance to show your car and tell everyone a little about it. Awards will be announced on August 24. Winners can drive their car to Corsa on August 30 to pick up their trophy, or if they prefer, we will ship the trophy to the winner’s address.

Registration is \$20.00 (Twenty Dollars) per car, if you would like a tee shirt it’s \$10 extra, for each entrant fee. If later, after you have seen all your buddies in these cool tee shirts and you feel left out, you can still buy one but the price will be \$15 plus shipping. Tee shirts will be shipped to everyone in the U.S. who registers on line and buys one. Show registration includes an automatic entry in a drawing for a Corsa exhaust system. The winner can choose any system in the Corsa catalog up to \$2,000 in value. For everyone who does not win, if you are registered for the show, Corsa Performance is offering a 15% discount on their products. If you are local they will even do a free install.

To register for the show, between July 22 and August 12 go to <https://www.corsaperformance.com/pages/corvettes-at-corsa-sign-up>. You can upload up to 3 pictures (typically car, engine, and interior), and in 200 words or less tell us about your car. Register as many cars as you like, but use a separate form for each car. If you would prefer to register in person, a station will be set up in the circle in front of Corsa Performance at 140 Blaze Industrial Parkway, Berea on July 26 from 9am to 1pm. You must not get out of your car and you must leave the area after registration is complete. We will have someone there to photograph your car.
