"IN THE BEGINNING"

Most people remember the first big turning point in their lives. For Andy it was the purchase of his BRIGHT RED 1955 CORVETTE, against his Father's wishes.

He was 23 years old, fresh from College and oh, so proud. The Corvette played a part in the rest of his life.

He put white racing stripes on the Corvette and drove around waving at other Corvettes that would pass. Stopping people on the street, he would ask if they would like to come to a Corvette Club meeting.

In those days the Dealerships would beg to have meetings in their show rooms. General Motors Division on the West side would host meetings and provide food. We made several visits as a club to the fiber glass factory to watch the forming of parts for the bodies of the Corvettes.

Later the National Corvette Club was formed. Many trips to Detroit to meet with Dick Wolf and his group evolved into a great National organization.

As interest in Corvettes grew, so did Corvette participation in racing. By the time Andy decided to get his racing license, we were married and we made the rounds of the road races sponsored by Sports Car Club of America: Dunkirk, NY., Virginia International, Wisconsin, Cumberland, MD,etc. all built on the runways of airports. We saw the Roosevelt Team, with Paul Whiteman as part owner, watching on the side. You could drive right up to the track, pitch a tent and sleep right there.

Andy never won, but he did get a trophy once for being the last Corvette running. We met so many wonderful people and had so many events that were great, it's hard to pick one that stands out.

Just being there was enough for Andy. The thrill of a lifetime.

EAST OHIO HALL OF FAME REQUIREMENTS (2/2019)

COMMITTEE:

The committee will consist of three or more regional members, one being the Regional Executive (RE), and shall be responsible for the nomination and voting procedure and will arrange and oversee the induction of the member(s) into the Hall of Fame at the East Ohio Region Banquet.

TIME LINE:

a). Annual nominations will be OPENED at the second regular regional meeting of the year. The Hall of Fame Committee will provide procedure and nomination forms to all club Governor's. (revised 2/19)

b). Nominations will close at the third (3rd) regional meeting. Nominees will be narrowed to no more than six by the Hall of Fame Committee within two weeks of that meeting.

c). Ballots will be handed out at the December regional meeting to all Governor's in attendance, with returned stamped envelopes, If a club is not represented at this meeting a ballot will be immediately mailed to the club governor at his home address. Biographies will be e-mailed to all governors prior to the December meeting. (revised 2/19)

d). Completed ballots are due back postmarked 30 days prior to the East Ohio Region banquet . A blank ballot is better than no ballot (revised 2/19)

REQUIREMENTS:

The nominee must have been a member in good standing of the EAST OHIO REGION for a minimum of fifteen (15) years. EXCEPTION: Death while still a member. (revised 2/19)

The nominee must have participated very actively in the past and present by promoting or helping the Region to prosper.

Paraphrased from original board of governors comments: The award recognizes the people who have made significant contributions of their time and effort to help East Ohio Region and N.C.C.C. prosper. Just as the Corvette is a prestigious automobile, such is the honor to obtain this award. (revised 2/19)

The field of what you can be nominated for is wide open, instead of using a list of what you can do the committee has chosen to allow the nominator to determine if a person qualifies. The nominator will use whatever they feel is applicable for this person. The Hall of Fame Committee will make the final determination if the person qualifies. (revised 2/19)

The nomination process will be yearly, if the nominee is not placed on the ballot, you can apply again the next year but must give better proof for consideration. If the nominee is placed on the ballot and does not make it they also can be re-nominated the next year and given more proof. Again the Hall of Fame committee will have final say so as to who goes on ballot. (revised 2/19)

The Qualification form is to be filled out by Regional member or Club and MUST be signed by nominator or Club Governor.

VOTING PROCEDURE:

a). The Governor of each Club in the East Ohio Region will have one (1) vote. The Club must be a member in good standing with current dues paid.

b). Governors may vote for NO MORE than (3) nominees.

c). The Hall of Fame Committee will count the votes.

d). The Nominee MUST have Eighty percent (80%) or more votes from the current clubs in region to be inducted into the Hall of Fame. (revised 2/19)

INDUCTEE RECOGNITION:

All Inductees into the Hall of Fame will be honored at the annual East Ohio Region banquet with a plaque, Hall of Fame pin, meal (published cost to attend banquet) provided by the Hall of Fame fund. Additionally, two pages in the Hall of Fame Photo Album will be reserved for each Inductee. Hotel cost will NOT be provided. (revised 2/19)
